### Religious Education

At St Benet's we believe that Religious Education is central to the educative mission of the Church. Religious Education is taught through the process of Explore, Reveal, Respond. This follows the pattern of: the human search for meaning, God's initiative in Revelation and the response in faith. We follow the 'Come and See' Catholic Primary Religious Education programme.

**MYSELF:** God knows and loves each person – the children will know and understand the importance of their name. They will know and understand that God knows and loves them each one by name

**WELCOME:** A welcome for a new baby. The children will know and understand what it is to welcome and be welcomed. They will know and understand Baptism: a welcome to God's family.

**BIRTHDAY:** Looking forward to Jesus' birthday. The children will know and understand what a birthday is; waiting for a birthday. They will know and understand Advent: looking forward to Christmas, the birthday of Jesus –

**SIKHISM:** Special days/ritual objects

**CELEBRATING:** People celebrate with the parish family. The children will know and understand what a celebration is. They will know and understand how the parish family celebrate.

**GATHERING:** The parish family gathers to celebrate Eucharist. The children will know and understand how and why people gather together. They will know and understand the joy of gathering together to celebrate at Mass.

**GROWING:** Looking forward to Easter. The children will know and understand Spring is a time when things begin to grow. They will know and understand Lent – a time to grow in love to be more like Jesus and to look forward to Easter.

**HINDUISM:** Special days/ritual objects- Diwali

**GOOD NEWS:** Passing on the Good News of Jesus. The children will know and understand that everyone has Good News to share. They will know and understand Pentecost: the celebration of the Good News of Jesus.

**FRIENDS:** Friends of Jesus. The children will know and understand we can make friends. They will know and understand Jesus had good friends; what Jesus tells us about friendship.

**OUR WORLD:** God's wonderful world. The children will know and understand what we love and wonder about our world. They will know and understand God gave us this wonderful world.
