<p style="text-align: center;">Religious Education</p> <p>At St Benet’s we believe that Religious Education is central to the educative mission of the Church. Religious Education is taught through the process of Explore, Reveal, Respond. This follows the pattern of: the human search for meaning, God’s initiative in Revelation and the response in faith. We follow the ‘Come and See’ Catholic Primary Religious Education programme.</p>	<p>FAMILIES: God’s love and care for every family – the children will know and understand ‘about the love and care shown in the family’. They will know and understand about God’s love and care for every family.</p> <p>BELONGING: Baptism: an invitation to belong to God’s family – the children will know and understand about belonging to different groups. They will know and understand that Baptism is an invitation to belong to God’s family.</p> <p>WAITING: Advent- a time to look forward to Christmas – the children will know and understand about the times that it is necessary to wait and the use of that time. They will know and understand about Advent: a time of waiting to celebrate Jesus’ coming at Christmas.</p> <p>SIKHISM: Stories/prayer and home.</p>	<p>SPECIAL PEOPLE: People in the parish family – the children know and understand that there are special people in our lives who are there to help. They will know and understand that on Sunday in church, we meet people who do special jobs as we gather to celebrate the Good News of Jesus.</p> <p>MEALS: Mass, Jesus’ special meal – the children will know and understand that families and groups share special meals. They will know and understand Mass as Jesus’ special meal.</p> <p>CHANGE: Lent: a time for change – the children will know and understand that we change and grow. They will know and understand that Lent is a time to change in preparation for the celebration of Easter.</p> <p>HINDUISM: Stories/prayer and home.</p>	<p>HOLIDAYS AND HOLYDAYS: Pentecost: feast of the Holy Spirit – the children will know and understand holidays as days to be happy. They will know and understand Pentecost; a holy day – the feast of the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>BEING SORRY: God helps us choose well – the children will know and understand we have choice – sometimes we choose well, and sometimes wrongly. They will know and understand God helps us to choose well and to be sorry. God forgives us.</p> <p>NEIGHBOURS: Neighbours share God’s world – the children know and understand neighbours all around. They will know and understand everyone is our neighbour and is loved by God.</p>
